Annual Nominations for election of General Committee positions 2020-21

The AIW is a not for profit organisation, incorporated under the Associations Act 1981 of Victoria. The Articles of Association state that voting members elect a Committee to represent them each year. Your Committee is comprised of Office Holders, comprising of; President, Vice President, Secretary, Treasurer, plus Ordinary members of the committee.

Your Committee comprises of voluntary members contributing their expertise for the common good of membership. Nominations outside Victoria may not be able to attend some meetings in person, but can nominate an Office Holder to represent their views or join into meetings via electronic media (Zoom). All committee nominations will be elected at the Annual General Meeting in November. Should Nominations exceed vacancies a Proxy Vote with a show of hands will determine the elections.

A member company may nominate more than one person to be represented on General Committee. Nomination Forms must be returned to the Honorary Secretary by closing day of 12th October 2020. Nominations will be displayed at the registered office a full month prior to the Annual General Meeting (AGM) on 10th November 2020. At the AGM a vote from members will elect the Committee for the coming year.
